### [Sketchbook](#)

A sketchbook is a place to explore and record. You should like your sketchbook, and it ought to feel good in your hands. It should have blank pages and an overall aesthetic that you like. Stores like Target, Barnes and Noble, and Hobby Lobby are stocked with great options. But the best sketchbook is one you already have. If you already own a sketchbook, don't worry about going out and buying a brand new one. Unless you want to. I won't stop you.

### [Colored Pencils](#)

### [Markers](#)

I would like students to have Crayola super tip markers specifically. They come in a variety of packages ranging from 20 to 100 markers. Any of the packs will work. If you are looking for more markers, I highly recommend the brand Tombow. They have a great line of [brush tip markers](#) that can be found at Walmart, Target and most craft stores. Their [fudenosuke](#) brush pens are some of my favorites, they are fantastic for drawing and writing. But the only necessities are the super tips :)

### [Pencil](#)

Any number 2 pencil or mechanical pencil.

### [Pencil Sharpener](#)

### [Eraser](#)
